Optional Practical Training

Mail your application with a **tracking number**.

U.S. Postal Service (USPS) deliveries

Express mail and courier deliveries

After mailing your application, you should receive a receipt notice in approximately 2-3 weeks. It will take several weeks or possibly months from the date on this receipt for you to receive notice about your approval or denial. If approved, once you have received your EAD card, you will need to scan and e-mail a copy of EAD to iss@csustan.edu.
